



YOUTH FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT (YFYD) Code of Conduct for Community Members

Youth for Youth Development (YFYD) is a community built on the principles of growth, collaboration, discipline, and mutual support. This Code of Conduct outlines the expectations and standards that every member must follow in order to maintain a productive and respectful environment within the community.

All members are expected to read, understand, and adhere to the following guidelines.

1. Commitment to the Community

- Clear and respectful communication is necessary for effective coordination within the community.

5. Social Media Engagement

- Members are encouraged to support the growth of YFYD by engaging with the community's official social media content.
- This includes liking, reacting, sharing, and promoting posts or videos whenever requested.
- Social media support plays an important role in increasing the reach and visibility of the community.

6. Responsibility Towards Tasks and Deadlines

- Members must complete assigned tasks, responsibilities, or projects within the specified deadlines.
- Tasks will always be allocated with the understanding that members are students with academic commitments.
- However, members are expected to manage their time responsibly and honor their commitments.

7. YFYD Accountability System (3-Strike Policy)

- Failure to do so will result in strikes:
 - 1st Strike: Reminder
 - 2nd Strike: Warning
 - 3rd Strike: Removal from the community
- No strike will be given if prior notice with a valid reason is approved by leadership.
- Submitting tasks before deadlines can remove one existing strike.
- All strikes will be publicly recorded to ensure transparency and accountability.
- Forgetting tasks or lack of communication is not considered a valid excuse.

8. Professional Behaviour and Respect

- All members must maintain professionalism, respect, and positive conduct when interacting with fellow members.
- Disrespectful behavior, negativity, or actions that harm the community environment will not be tolerated.
- Members should promote a culture of encouragement, learning, and collaboration.

9. Activity and Engagement Standards

- Members are expected to remain active, responsive, and participative within the community.
- Passive membership without engagement goes against the purpose of the community.
- Every member plays an important role in strengthening the collective network.

10. Inactivity and Removal Policy

Members may be removed from the community if they repeatedly demonstrate the following:

- Frequent absence from meetings without valid reasons.
- Failure to complete assigned tasks or responsibilities.
- Continuous inactivity within the official communication platforms.
- Lack of participation in discussions, initiatives, or community activities.

Youth for Youth Development values discipline, responsibility, and consistency, and these principles are considered non-negotiable for the growth of the community.
